



Quick Start Guide: The Great Easter Power Egg Hunt

Follow these simple steps to bring the Easter Power Egg Hunt to life

What You'll Need:

- 5–10 plastic or paper eggs
 - Printable **Power Egg Cards**
 - Optional small treats (jellybeans, stickers, etc.)
 - About 30-45 minutes of family time
 - Optional: silly hats, costumes, bunny hops!

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Print & Pick Your Power Eggs

Download and print the 9 **Easter Power Egg Cards**.

Write an Easter Power, you'd like your family to show. Double-Up if you need more.

2. Fill and Hide Your Eggs

Place one Power Egg card in each egg. Add a treat. Then hide the eggs around your home or garden like a classic Easter hunt.

3. Hunt & Celebrate

When all eggs are found:

- Read the power out loud.
 - Ask: "Who showed this Easter Power recently?"
 - Act it out just for fun!

4. Choose Your Family's Top 3 Easter Powers

After the hunt, gather together. Vote on your **Top 3 Family Easter Powers** and display them using the printable **Easter Power Poster**.



 **Bonus Magic Tips:**

- Use silly voices or hop like bunnies between eggs!
 - Give powers nicknames (e.g., “Captain Giggles”).
 - Start with a cozy storytime: **“The Bunny Who Saw with His Heart”** (video link on our site!).
